

Dear Friends of the CT Food Association:

State address to the General Assembly on February 7th. Lamont noted that eight months ago we passed a two-year budget which, unlike most of our peer states, is still in the black. With this budget the state has made the largest ever commitment to childcare, K-12 education, our universities, workforce training and not-for-profits. Governor Lamont also stated our budget provided a 10% tax cut for the middle-class families and a bigger tax credit for working families and essential workers. Legislative committees have now begun the public hearing process. The legislature adjourns at midnight on May 8th.
